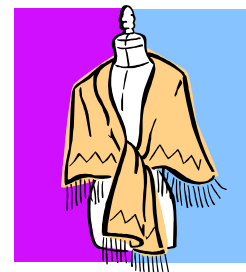

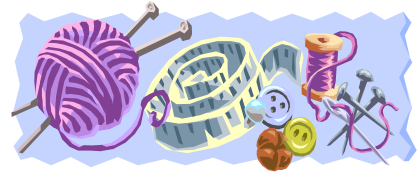

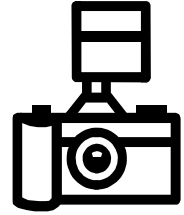

- Subject need not necessarily be centred for the picture to be effective
